

Extra Credit - 20 points

- 1) You will **listen and evaluate** your classmate's interviews on your web page.
- 2) You will **not** evaluate your own team member's interviews.
- 3) You will **write a summary** (*in MSWord/100-200 words*) of the best interview **on each team**.
- 4) Your Word Document file will be saved as **GroupName_Last Name**.
- 5) You will email me a copy of your MS Word Document. **10 pts.**

*6) You will then, post these **4 summaries** (*cut and paste*) on your particular web page.
(*each summary is 50-100 words*). **10 pts.**

You need a criteria - a plan to evaluate

Why did you choose these people? What attracted you to their interview? Are they organized, serious, clear, optimistic, friendly. . . To help you discern who the best candidate is; How did they answer the Physics question? Would you hire this person or better, yet. Would you accept their application to Grad School?

This is what Interviewers have to do. They need to sum people up quickly, efficiently and accurately. I want to see how you chose the best student interviews. You should have a section to show what criteria you used in your evaluation. You can't just listen to four students and call it a day. The students you write about will be thrilled!

Think of a set of particulars that you would use in evaluating your classmates

Excellent - Enthusiastic, Friendly, Informative, Knowledgeable, Helpful

Satisfactory - Somewhat enthusiastic, cagey, only answers the question stated, etc

Needs Work - unenthusiastic, hates physics, wants to go back to the beach, etc.

First, you create your own criteria! Then, use that criteria to evaluate your classmates. It will take about 30 minutes to create your criteria. It will take an hour to listen to their interviews and an hour to write it up. This will be one of the most useful assignments you will ever do!

It's your choice. It's extra credit!

***When you cut and paste into the website on the right side, please be careful.** Use your real name. Cut and paste your summary into the box below your name. Your summaries should already be error free. Then, hit submit. PLEASE hit submit only once. Then, do not hit refresh or you will duplicate what you cut and paste. Rather, go back to the student group index page (hit the back button) and then return. Paste one summary at a time. It's easier to read. You should be posting 4 summaries on the website. Thanks.
